

Installation Instructions for 72KC-75KC Key-in-Knob Cylinders

These instructions describe how to install a Key-in-Knob Cylinder into a 7KC BEST lever handle. Use these instructions only after completing the installation of the cylindrical chassis. For standard 7KC cylindrical lock installation instructions see T80622 — *Installation Instructions for 72KC-75KC Cylindrical Locks*.

Follow these steps to install the key-in-knob cylinder in a 7KC lever handle.

1 A

Assemble and install key-in-knob cylinder

- 1 From the bag of keys, cylinders, and throw members, keep only the shortest throw member. Discard the other throw members they will not be needed.
- 2 Remove the outside lever if it's not already off.




Figure 1 Assembling the throw member to the key-in-knob cylinder

- 3 Assemble the key-in-knob cylinder as shown in Figure 1.

Note 1: Make sure that the throw member blade is installed aligned with the cylinder 'bible' as shown in Figure 1. This prevents unauthorized removal of the cylinder.

Note 2: Do not disassemble the cylinder with the key inserted. Doing so may cause the pins to fall out.




Figure 2 Installing the key-in-knob cylinder assembly

4 Install the key-in-knob cylinder assembly into the handle See Figure 2.

2 Install the lever insert and lever handle





Figure 3 Installing the lever insert

1 Install the lever insert as shown in Figure 3. Make sure that the lever insert is completely seated.

For R function locks only

 Turn the cam counterclockwise until it stops, then rotate clockwise 45 degrees (or until it aligns with the clearance area on the lever keeper). See Figure 4.

For all function locks

2 Insert the key into the cylinder.

For R function locks only

■ Turn the key 45 degrees clockwise.

For all function locks

- 3 Push on the lever handle until it stops.
- 4 Push the lever on until it is completely seated.
- 5 Remove the key from the cylinder.

3 Removing the lever

For R function locks only

■ Insert the key into the cylinder and turn the key 45 degrees.

For all function locks

- 1 Depress the keeper with a tool.
- 2 Remove the lever.
